- 12/9/11**
(E-88) **Last Day for Jurisdiction to file Resolution**
Deadline for jurisdiction to submit a resolution for the local measure to be placed on the ballot.
- 12/19/11**
(E-78) **Measure Arguments, Impartial Analysis Deadline**
Last day for proponents/opponents to file arguments for or against the local measure; also deadline to submit impartial analysis prepared by county counsel.
- 12/29/11**
(E-68) **Rebuttals Deadline**
Last day for proponents/opponents to submit rebuttal arguments for or against the local measure.
- 2/6/12**
(E-29) **Absentee Mailing Date**
First day, allowable by law, all-mail ballots can be sent.
- 2/21/12**
(E-15) **Close of Registration**
The last day for any U.S. citizen to register to vote for the special tax election. §§2102, 2107
- 2/28/12**
(E-7 business days) **Process Absentee Ballots**
The first day to begin the opening of Absentee Ballots. Voted Absentee Ballots will be received, processed and opened. **NO results** will be tallied. Public is invited to view process. Contact Elections Department if a representative will be present to view the process. §15000
- 3/6/12** **ELECTION DAY**
All Ballots must be received by the Yolo County Elections Office no later than 8PM on this date. There will also be a box to deposit ballots in the Davis Library which will also be open til 8pm on election day. Ballots postmarked on or before election day but received after election day will not be counted. §3020
