

Offices and Incumbents Up for Election

All offices are qualified and elected “At-Large” unless specified as elected “By-District” area. Candidates required to live in their district and, due to boundary line changes, may no longer reside in those districts. Candidates who have questions regarding which districts they reside in may contact the Yolo County Elections Office at (530) 666-8133.

This special vacancy election is for the remainder of an unexpired term, which ends in December 2024, in the City of Davis City Council District 3. GOV § 36512; EC § 10720(b)

The top candidate for this contest will fill the vacancy and hold the office for the unexpired term of the former incumbent.

On June 7, 2022, Yolo County held an election for Yolo County Supervisor, District 2. Davis Mayor Lucas Frerichs was elected by a majority of voters and was sworn in as Yolo County District 2 Supervisor on January 2, 2023, taking office January 3, 2023. This created a vacancy on the City of Davis City Council for the remainder of his term as Davis councilmember for District 3 (term concludes after the November 2024 election). This city council position was elected in the November 3, 2020, General Election using the new 2019 district boundaries as the city council moved from At-Large to By-District elections. This means that the 2020 census boundaries for this particular district will not be applicable until the November 2024 election.
