A person who has filed a Declaration of Candidacy shall be appointed by the supervising authority at a regular or special meeting held prior to the first Monday before the first Friday in December. If no one filed, another qualified person shall be appointed by the supervising authority on or before the election date and shall take office and serve as if elected. Districts must take action to make applications available to persons interested in serving on the board if an insufficient number of nominees or no nominees have filed.
